YOU Can Help Protect Nesting Birds

Nesting season for Colorado birds overlaps with Spring tree trimming. Please **STOP** and work around the birds!



Dates you are most likely to find adults, eggs, and nests:
April 1st-August 15th
Hawks and Owls nest as early as *February!*

It can be illegal to continue working!
Nests, eggs, young birds, and sitting adults are protected under the *Federal Migratory Bird Treaty Act*,
16 U.S.C 703-712 &
Colorado Statute 33-6-128



Dead trees that do not pose a threat to public safety and structures should be preserved - they provide nesting and foraging sites for birds including owls, woodpeckers, kestrels, and chickadees.
