

YOU Can Help Protect Nesting Birds

Nesting season for Colorado birds overlaps with Spring tree trimming. Please STOP and work around the birds!



Dates you are most likely to find adults, eggs, and nests:

April 1st-August 15th

Hawks and Owls nest as early as February!

It can be illegal to continue working!

Nests, eggs, young birds, and sitting adults are protected under the Federal Migratory Bird Treaty Act,

16 U.S.C 703-712 & Colorado Statute 33-6-128



Dead trees that do not pose a threat to public safety and structures should be preserved - they provide nesting and foraging sites for birds including owls, woodpeckers, kestrels, and chickadees.
